- 1. A floating city off the coast may sound like science fiction, but it could be reality in the not-too-distant future. A research institute has drawn up plans for a floating city off the coast. The institute already has drawn up plans for the construction of a homestead on the Pacific Ocean. One project engineer described the prototype as similar to a cruise ship, but from a distance the cities might look like oil-drilling platforms. According to the plans, the floating cities would not only look different from their land-based counterparts, but they might operate differently, too. (20%)
- 2. Social networks are everywhere. They've been around since long before your grandmother's knitting circle, and chances are they'll still be around in some form or another for our descendants -- whether they're colonizing far-off star systems or digging among the future ruins of our current civilization. The Internet itself began as a sort of social network; as its reach extended, so did its uses. - 3. WPAN and WLAN are complementary rather than competing technologies. While there are certainly many devices where different radio technologies can be built into the same platform (e.g., Bluetooth in a cellular phone), collocation of Wi-Fi and Bluetooth is of special significance because both occupy the 2.4 GHz frequency band.
