National Dong Hwa University Undergraduate Guidelines for the University General Education Requirements (For Students admitted into NDHU on or before Fall 2012)

- I. Undergraduate students must complete 39 University General Education credits and 4 Physical Education credits before graduation.
- II. Total credits for each category in the General Education Program

Languages: 12 credits

Arts and Humanities: 8 credits or above

Social Sciences: 8 credits or above

Mathematics and the Sciences: 8 credits or above

Physical Education: 4 credits, including Physical Education 1, 2, 3, and 4

Total required credits for the following three categories, Arts and Humanities, Social Sciences, and Mathematics and the Sciences, must be at least 27 credits.

- III. For international students: credits for English-taught courses offered by respective enrolled colleges can be transferred over to General Education credits and are not subject to the maximum of 9 credits.
- IV. Students must complete Physical Education 1 and Physical Education 2 in their first study year and Physical Education 3 and Physical Education 4 in their second year and/or subsequent years of study before graduation.
- V. Students must complete Service Learning 1 and Service Learning 2 by graduation.
- VI. Credits for General Education courses related to students' majors are not applicable to the General Education Requirements.
- VII. Some General Education courses are cross-categorical courses. Students can decide which category to attribute their credits via the <u>Student Graduation Management System</u> in their final semester of study.
- VIII. All courses offered by the General Education Department are planned on a rotating basis every two years (i.e. every four semesters).
- IX. Credits from cross-campus distance learning courses are applicable to General Education Requirements. For the list of categories and information about such courses, please refer to the announcement from the General Education Center.
- X. Students must decide for themselves the most applicable and beneficial course policy of the General Education Requirements in the first semester of their final study year. The selected policy of General Education Requirements does not have to be the same as the course policy of a student's major.
